1) User Manual: *This was specific to the “Telangitron” but could be helpful in using your machine. There are also a few helpful tips.*

2) Cookbook: *This was handed out at trade shows. Use this if you are making a presentation to a physician or other interested person.*

3) Important Issues: *These are notes on a few techniques you might want to employ.*

4) Patient Short Form: *This is a short “consent form” you may use before treatment.*

5) Patient Long Form: *This is a more thorough “consent form” you may want to use.*

6) Patient Instructions: *Give this to your patient before the treatment, after your consultation.*

7) Who Should Use the Blend: *Notes on legality and other issues.*

8) Slick: *This was a glossy handout that was used at trade shows. Use this, perhaps in your office?*

9) 3-fold T-Tron: *This is a 3-fold pamphlet intended for your office waiting room. (If you want specific language changed, you may contact me and I can make a special pamphlet for you.)*
